drag

drag

to pull or move along
heavily or slowly;
to pull or draw along

flex

to bend

glider

a winged aircraft
without an engine;
rising air currents
keep it up in the air

hangars

buildings for storing
aircraft

rudder

a flat piece of wood or
metal hinged vertically
to the rear end of an
aircraft and used to
steer it

stalled

stopped or brought to
a standstill, usually
against your wish
